Creating the San Diego River Park and Trail System
The San Diego River Park Foundation is the only non-profit organization that is dedicated to being the leading voice for establishing the 52 mile long San Diego River Park and its associated San Diego River Trail system. Working in collaboration with public agencies, user and other interested groups, the organization is recognized as the champion of the vision of the River Park. As part of this program, the San Diego River Park Foundation is working to build a new education center and park in Mission Valley, a heritage museum and other components of the River Park plan. In 2014, permits were submitted for the 17 acre Discovery Center at Grant Park, which are still being processed as design work advances.

Community Engagement
The signature program of the organization is to engage people in creating a better future for the San Diego River. This program brings together dozens of organizations and public agencies to host the annual San Diego River Days and River Kids Discovery Days as well as other community events. In addition, the program manages 4 public park areas and works in other areas throughout the watershed to organize volunteer activities. More than 22,000 hours of service were organized by this program in 2015.

Save the Source: Water and Land Conservation
The upper reaches of the San Diego River are considered a globally significant ecosystem with perhaps the most biodiversity of any place in the continental United States. This program works to acquire, conserve and care for critical pieces of this landscape to strengthen the biological integrity of this fragile and threatened system while supporting watershed health, appropriate recreation and public enjoyment. This program has conserved more than 3,000 acres of land since its founding and manages wildlife preserves in three geographic areas of the upper San Diego River.

Form 990 Part III Line 4d: Healthy River Healthy Communities: \$87,895. This program works towards a trash free and healthy San Diego River through monitoring, surveying and action activities as well as serving as an expert on the condition of the San Diego River and its 440 square mile watershed. Portions of the watershed are listed on the EPA's impaired water list and this program takes a leadership role in citizen science and volunteer involvement to work toward a healthier ecosystem. More than 75 tons of trash was removed and 100 sites were monitored during 2015. We completed comprehensive surveys of more than 20 miles of the River twice during 2015.

Form 990 Part III Line 4d: Youth Education: \$68,352. The key to the future health of the San Diego River and associated ecosystems is fostering engagement and understanding of youth. This program organizes hands-on learning experiences both along the River and at one of the River Park Foundation's three wildlife preserves as well as attends community festivals and other events. In 2015 more than 2000 students participated in hands-on nature-based learning experiences.

Form 990 Part VI Line 11b: The Form 990 is prepared by the Accountant and reviewed by the Executive Director. Once the Form 990 has been approved by Staff, and before being submitted to the Internal Revenue Service, the Board Finance Committee is provided a copy for review and comment.

Form 990 Part VI Line 12c: The Conflict of Interest policy is provided to all incoming Board Members prior to joining the Board of Directors. A policy is provided to the Board of Directors each year at the annual meeting. Prior to each Board action at its meetings, Board Members are given the opportunity to disclose any conflicts that they, or any other Board Member may have with the proposed action.

Form 990 Part VI Line 15: The Executive Committee of the Board of Directors reviews and considers the compensation of the Executive Director annually. As part of this process, at least two salary comparison studies are reviewed. The Board of Directors approves the compensation of the Executive Director as part of its annual approval and adoption of the organization's annual budget.
